Tournament Format:

- Each team bowls 4 games of qualifying across 8 lanes. Results of each squad will be combined to make final results.
- Besides normal sidepots offered, Adult Bowlers can pay extra \$30 (all prize fund) to go towards the side adult event. Individual adult scores will be used for a "Singles Adult Event" within the adult junior. Adult Sidepot Event is only Scratch.

Tournament Rules:

- **Teams MUST consist of 1 Sanctioned Youth Bowler and 1 Sanctioned Adult Bowler.** Bowlers may compete in scratch or handicap division, based on the sum of each bowler's average. Scratch is based on 400/game. Handicap division is 90% of 400 with the difference in average of the two bowlers. Handicap teams' average total must be 404 or less. **All average teams over a total of 405 must bowl scratch.**
- Event is open to USBC JUNIOR / ADULT bowlers under the age of 21 as of 8/1/21.
- Fees: \$13.75 bowling, \$23.00 prize, \$3.25 expenses - \$40.00 total – If paying \$50, \$10 extra goes all into prize fund.
**** Bowlers can use earned Scholarship Money in MAPS account to enter tournament if they choose ****
- Bowlers who sign up in advance and make the 2nd round of the main BEST Tournament can elect to receive a refund.
- Entries are first-come, first-served. Walk-in entries are only accepted if space permits. **MAX 56 Teams Per Squad**
- All bowlers must use their highest USBC JUNIOR / ADULT sanctioned average for 2020-2021 (at least 21 games). Tournament will follow PJBT Average rules. Verification of average is the bowler's responsibility. Reporting a false average may result in disqualification by tourn director.
- Tournament management requires suitable attire and behavior. Suggested wardrobe includes collared shirt and khaki/dress pants. All PJBT rules will be enforced. Tournament management will make all other rulings.
- All winnings for youth will be deposited and managed by the PJBT Maps Scholarship Portal.
