Tournament Format:

- Each bowler competes on a 5 person team. They will bowl 5 games of qualifying. All individual bowler's scores are added together to make team total for each game. +/- based on 1000 a game. Handicap Division is 90% of difference of team average from 1000.
- After 5 games, the top 6 teams in each division advance to our football playoff bracket final. Seeds 1&2 receive a bye and a 1 game match is conducted head-to-head...seeds 3vs6 and 4vs5. Winners advance to bowl seeds 1&2. Winners advance to bowl each other in the title match.



Tournament Rules:

- Each bowling center of our hosting centers are eligible to compete and send 2 teams, 1 scratch and 1 handicap to the event. Centers will be permitted to enter more than 1 team in each division if space permits. If a bowler or bowlers are sanctioned in a center, we do not attend....they are also welcome to enter a team but all bowlers must be sanctioned from that center.
- Event is open to USBC JUNIOR / ADULT bowlers under the age of 21 as of 8/1/22.
- Bowlers who compete on each team MUST be a SANCTIONED JUNIOR/ADULT BOWLER of the program they are bowling on. In addition, each bowler must have bowled at least 9 games of league bowling as of tournament date to qualify to bowl. Bowlers will be asked to show and verify their sanction at check-in. The only exception will be bowlers who compete from out-of-state. Teams from multiple centers from out of state only will be granted by tournament management.
- Teams may compete in scratch or handicap division, based on the sum of each bowler's average. Scratch is based on 1000/game. Handicap division is 90% of 1000 with the difference in average of the five bowlers. Handicap teams' average total must be 999 or less. **All average teams over a total of 1000 must bowl scratch.**
- Bowlers MUST check in as a team. Check-in closes at 10:30AM.
- Top 4 OR 6 teams in each division will earn scholarships and awards based on entries from our award sponsor, Crown Trophy.
- Fees: \$15.00 bowling, \$18.00 prize, \$2.00 awards, \$4.50 expenses, \$0.50 scholarship fund; \$40.00 total.** Walk-in entries pay an extra \$5 per bowler....all of which would also into the prize fund.
- All bowlers must use their highest USBC JUNIOR / ADULT sanctioned average for 2021-2022 (at least 21 games). If no 21-game average for 2021-2022 has been established, highest average from summer 2021 or 2020-2021 season may be used. **If Bowlers' average for this season is currently 10 pins or more higher than their highest 2021-2022 average, the higher average MUST BE USED if 21 games or more bowled. High School Averages will also be accepted if 21 or more games bowled.** If no average, bowler enters scratch with 200 avg.
- Verification of average is the bowler's responsibility. Reporting a false average may result in disqualification by tourn director.
- Tournament management requires suitable attire and behavior. Suggested wardrobe includes collared shirt and khaki/dress pants. Inappropriate attire may result in denial of entry. All USBC JUNIOR / ADULT rules will be enforced. Tournament management will make all other rulings. ALL additional PJBT rules apply.
