Tournament Format & Schedule:

- Each bowler will bowl 10 Games of Qualifying on Saturday. 5 Games bowled at each center on different lane conditions. After 10 games, the top 16 Bowlers advance to Sunday's competition
- Day 2 will consist of a double elimination bracket. Each match will be 2 games. Bowlers are not eliminated until they lose two head-to-head matches. All bowlers who make it to Day 2 win a scholarship

Tournament Rules:

- Event is open to USBC JUNIOR / ADULT bowlers under the age of 21 as of 8/1/23.
- Bowlers who compete can compete in either scratch or handicap....based on their highest league average for current bowling season (23-24) or last year (22-23), whichever one is highest. PJBT averages will also be accepted and used if the PJBT average is higher than all their league averages. Bowlers with an average over 205 must bowl scratch.
- Verification of average is the bowler's responsibility. Reporting a false average may result in disqualification by tourn director.
- Check-in begins at each center on Saturday at 10:30am. Entries will be accepted at the door as long as space permits.
- Fees: \$34.00 bowling, \$60.00 prize, \$6.00 awards/expenses; \$100.00 total. – Bowlers paying \$140, \$40 extra into prize fund.
- Tournament management requires suitable attire and behavior. Suggested wardrobe includes collared shirt and khaki/dress pants. Inappropriate attire may result in denial of entry. All USBC JUNIOR / ADULT rules will be enforced. Tournament management will make all other rulings. ALL additional PJBT rules apply.

1st PLACE = \$1500	5TH & 6TH PLACE = \$150 EACH
2ND PLACE = \$750	7TH & 8TH PLACE = \$125 EACH
3rd PLACE = \$500	9TH THRU 12TH PLACE = \$100 EACH
4TH PLACE = \$250	13TH THRU 16TH PLACE = \$80 EACH
